Wisznat/LeFavre Memorial Scholarship Update Information For High School Seniors and College Students

With the wonderful news that the 2024 Wisznat/LeFavre Memorial Scholarship award will be increasing from \$750 to \$1000 for qualifying applicants, new guidelines have been established to recognize candidates as active church members, a mandatory component for our church scholarship. Below you will find a list of church-based activities with assigned point values. Each candidate will be required to accrue a minimum of 10 points over the course of a school year and log each of their actions in the Scholarship Applicants' Notebook located in the back of the church. As students are being notified of this change mid-year, they will only need to earn 5 points for the 2024 scholarship application by the mid-June deadline. This log will be one part of the application process that will become available in the spring.

Minimum points needed to qualify as an active church member : 10 (5 points for 2024)

1 point activity:

• Attend church service

2-point activities: attend and participate in MCC church service

- Greeter
- Usher
- Reader during the service
- Teach Sunday School
- PB&J sandwich session

3-point activities: participate in MCC service opportunity events

- Assembling hygiene kits for Salvation Army clients
- Set up/serve/ clean up coffee hour
- Set up/serve/ clean up church luncheon or dinner event
- Set up/ volunteer/break down MCC August Arts & Craft Show
- Participate in Live Nativity
- Assisting in Spring Fling & Flower Sale
- Assisting in Cherry Blossom Festival
- Documented community service activity sponsored by your college or high school (one event per year)

These activities are suggested as they represent important aspects of the life of our church, and many could be completed during breaks in the school calendar. Please note: *Candidates are responsible for recording each of their activities in the Scholarship Applicants' Notebook <u>as they complete them</u>.*
