This log will be one part of the application process.

Minimum points needed to qualify as an active church member: 10

1 point activity:

• Attend church service

2-point activities: attend and participate in MCC church service

- Greeter
- Usher
- Reader during the service
- Teach Sunday School
- PB&J sandwich session

3-point activities: participate in MCC service opportunity events

- Assembling hygiene kits for Salvation Army clients
- Set up/serve/ clean up coffee hour
- Set up/serve/ clean up church luncheon or dinner event
- Set up/volunteer/break down MCC August Arts & Craft Show
- Participate in Live Nativity
- Assisting in Spring Fling & Flower Sale
- Assisting in Cherry Blossom Festival
- Documented community service activity sponsored by your college or high school (one event per year)

These activities are suggested as they represent important aspects of the life of our church, and many could be completed during breaks in the school calendar. Please note: *Candidates are responsible for recording each of their activities in the Scholarship Applicants' Notebook as they complete them.*
